THE FAMILY AT MARYLEBONE

The information given under this heading was acquired when searching for the bridging of the Lowestoft and Sunderland Families. The earliest mentioned was

Ambrose Farratt (1720) who married a Mary to produce

and the following were possibly of the same family:

John Ferratt (1765)
Silas Ferrett (1768)

The brackets are mine to indicate a probable birth date.

Will Farratt 1760 married a Mary to produce

Thomas Ferratt, 31st August 1782

Samuel Andrew Farratt 1760 married Sarah Wright, 16th April 1783.

John Ferratt 1765 married Mary Barugh, 19th April 1790

Silas Ferrett 1768 married a Jane to produce an

Eliza Ferrett (no date known)

The next entry is

Elizabeth Fairhead (1745) who married William Clutterback on the 4th July 1768. The witness at this marriage was **Isaac Fairhead** possibly her father.

Now there is a generation gap which is concluded by bringing John Fairhead (1785) into the picture by his marriage to Elizabeth Sandon on the 10th July 1810. Is this the founder of the Sunderland family?

The following family is recorded to John Nicholson Fairhead and Elizabeth:

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There were two Ferrett's born about this time:

William Robert, 28th October 1821 and
Mary, 29th May 1823 (of Robert Ferrett & Sarah Rees)

There was an Austin Fairhead who was married on 29th March, 1871. (No Bride given)

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Since the death of Albert (in 1976) material has been gathered by the late Mr. G. T. Fairhead, myself and fellowship members in general and added to Albert's work to give a fuller and more informative story. The subsequent record is compiled from Albert's original book and the new information collected since that time. It should be noted that the generation numbers do not start at one, but carry on from a previous branch, in this case The Parish Clerk, which in turn carried on from the Suffolk Weavers.

Where places are described as a 'District', this is the Registration District where the event was registered. Civil Registration was introduced in 1837, the Index's to these entries can now be viewed online, it should be noted that the names and

boundaries of many of these Districts have changed over the years. A list of these districts can be found at <http://www.ukbmd.org.uk/genuki/reg/districts/index.html>

Where individuals have "No record" next to their entry there may be an entry in the "Don't Know" section, but there is not enough evidence to link to the person concerned. ----- Between individuals denotes different families, --- between individuals denotes the division between step siblings in one family.

n.b. It is quite possible that this family links in with "**The London Butchers**" branch, only time will tell. The common link is with Marylebone in London.

The next entry is :-

Elizabeth (Fairhead) (1745) ⁽³²⁰⁴⁾ who married William **Clutterbuck** ⁽³²⁰³⁾ on the 4th July 1768, at St. Marylebone Parish Church, Marylebone, London. The witness at this marriage was Isaac Fairhead ⁽³⁵⁷¹⁾ probably her father.

Now there is a generation gap, which is concluded by bringing **John Fairhead (1785)** ⁽³²⁰⁵⁾ into the picture by his marriage to Elizabeth **Sandon** ⁽³²⁰⁶⁾ on the 10th July 1810, at St. Marylebone Parish Church, Marylebone, London.

There were two **Ferrett's** born about this time:-

William Robert ⁽⁴³¹⁴⁾ bap 28th October 1821
At St. Mary, Marylebone

(the son of Robert Ferrett ⁽⁴³²⁸⁾ and Ann ? ⁽⁴³²⁹⁾)

And

Mary ⁽⁴³¹⁵⁾ b 29th May 1823

(the daughter of Robert Ferrett ⁽⁴³¹⁶⁾ & Sarah Rees ⁽⁴³¹⁷⁾)

It is not known if these two are related, or connected to the family above.

There is a possibility that there two families involved here, (although except for the first child they were all baptised at St. Mary's, Marylebone in London), or that some of the children died and their names were used again for succeeding children, a not uncommon practice in those days. As there is very little information about the children they have been classed as one family. The information on these children is as follows :-

Alfred John 1827 ⁽³¹⁴⁶⁾ No record.

(John 1811 is thought to have died and **Susannah** ⁽⁵⁸⁵⁹⁾ then married James **Turpin** ⁽⁴⁵⁴⁴⁾ on the 7th October 1860 at St. Matthew, Bethnal Green, London. Susannah's father was stated to be Thomas **Underwood** ⁽³⁴⁴⁰⁾.)

Emma Frances 1872 ⁽⁷⁰⁰⁰⁾ was a Charwoman, living at 81 Malvern Rd., Kilburn, London in 1911. She married Gilbert J. Fright ⁽⁷⁴⁴⁸⁾ in the 1Q 1912, in the Willesden District, London.

At James Johnson 1873 ⁽³⁴⁰⁹⁾ was baptized at St. Luke Old Street, Finsbury, London. He married Ada Rebecca **Randall** ⁽³⁹³⁵⁾ (b 1Q 1880 Pitts Place, Long Acre, London) in the 3Q 1906, in the Pancras District, London, and they had the following family :-
