

THE SUFFOLK WEAVERS.

Introductory notes.

This composition covers the genealogical history of the Family from the early days of the fifteenth century, when they settled in the Parish of South Elmham in Suffolk, until today with its descendants scattered far and wide throughout the country.

Early records are somewhat vague and cannot be vouched for accurately, but every attempt has been made to ensure that they are as correct as the ancient documentary material will allow.

Doubtless a number of readers will fault some of the statements made and may be able to give a truer account of the happenings. This can be only part of the full story and any additions will be most welcome.

Since the death of Albert (in 1976) material has been gathered by the late Mr. G.T. Fairhead, myself and fellowship members in general and added to Albert's work to give a fuller and more informative story. This record is compiled from Albert's original book and the new information collected since that time. It should be noted that the name of Fairhead was not always spelt this way, and where it is found to be different the variation is in brackets. Also, for ease of tracing family lines the generation numbers have been carried through to all other branches mentioned in this booklet.

Where places are described as a 'District', this is the Registration District where the event was Registered. These were introduced in 1837, and the names and boundaries of many of these Districts have changed over the years since. The First Phase.

Weaving, one of the oldest crafts, perhaps next to that of agriculture, has been practised in England since before medieval times. It is said to have been introduced at the time of the Roman Invasion to provide clothing for its army of occupation. During the earliest period, food and body protection came from the hunted beast, and clothing made from wool of the sheep. History suggests that the craft of weaving was perpetuated by our forebears from the Scandinavian countries and was practised by the Fairhead family from the very early days to well into the eighteenth century.

The township of South Elmham in the county of Suffolk was a large centre for this activity. It was at that time a large and important weaving area covering some five parishes, the Bishop's Palace gracing the parish of All Saints with Saint Nicholas.

The 1st Generation.

It was in this parish in the year 1443 that we have the first record of the Fairhead family, that of :-

Andrew (Ffayerhead) ⁽¹⁾ occupying first 7 acres, then 5 acres and then a further 4 acres with house etc. This area was the beginning of considerable stretches of land acquired from time to time by the family in order to satisfy the appetite forever increasing numbers of sheep needed to supply wool for the weavers' looms. It is suspected that Andrew took the name of Fairhead from the female side of the family, quite common in those days when there was property to be handed down, as his name is recorded as Andrew Ffayerhead (alias **Launce**), and it is quite probable that Launce was his father's name. He married Margaret ? ⁽²⁾ and had two sons :-

The 2nd Generation.

John 1418 ⁽³⁾ it appears moved south to Tollesbury, Essex, to continue sheep farming. (Could this be the link to "The Essex Farmers").

Andrew died in 1451 and the lands passed to Henry (Ffayerhead) 1422 on the 14th October of that year, as it was the custom in those days for the youngest son to inherit the property. This property included commodious houses with an interior of great height to accommodate the weaving looms. Each house had a cellar, which supported a ceiling of great strength where the wool could be hung and stored in a cool temperature. Such were the houses of the Fairhead weavers of that day and it is possible that some still remain today.

Henry 1422 ⁽⁴⁾ married Alice ? ⁽⁵⁾ and the records suggest that there were two sons :-

However, Henry, the father, died on the 25th July 1473 and Alice continued with the Weaving business until her death at the end of the century when son Henry (1448) took over the business.

The 3rd Generation.

Nicholas 1445 ⁽⁶⁾ Albert could not find any further record to the older son of Henry 1422.

Henry 1448 ⁽⁷⁾ Henry's stay at the weavers loom was brief, as in the same year as his son was admitted to the property. There appears to be no mention of the wife ⁽⁸⁾ of Henry 1448. Their son was :-

The 4th Generation.

John 1470 ⁽⁹⁾ married Margaret ? ⁽¹⁰⁾ and they had two sons :-

John died in 1503, leaving all to his wife Margaret who continued in the business, doubtless assisted by her youngest son Thomas who was admitted to the lands at a very young age on the 25th April 1515.

The 5th Generation.

Richard 1495 ⁽¹¹⁾ left South Elmham for some reason. A rational conclusion is that the business having passed to his younger brother Thomas, he possibly decided that a move was in his best interests. He travelled north to the Norfolk border and finally settled in the town of Beccles, Suffolk. Here he married Margaret ? ⁽¹³⁾ and a son was born :-

Richard died in January 1584 and was buried in the churchyard at Beccles, Suffolk. His estate was left to Margaret, his wife, for life and after her decease, to Thomas the son. Albert could find no record of any other children of Richard & Margaret, but the son Thomas may have perpetuated the family name.

Thomas 1500 ⁽¹²⁾ married another Margaret ? ⁽¹⁵⁾ and they produced a fairly large family thus :-

Thomas, it appears was an important figure in the township of South Elmham and is mentioned in a number of times in the records for that period. He was one of the greatest Master Weavers of that day. He died in 1553 and was buried in Saint Nicholas, South Elmham. The church has now disappeared but the burial ground is still marked. His Will named Margaret his wife and Anthony his eldest son named as Executors. The estate was left to Margaret for her life, it then passed to Anthony with beneficial provisions for all the other members of the family.

The 6th Generation.

Thomas 1520 ⁽¹⁴⁾ No record.

Anthony 1525 ⁽¹⁶⁾ married Mary ? ⁽²³⁾ and they had three children :-

At about this time there was a recession in the Wool Trade and although this was only temporary, the Fairhead Family it appears were not very happy with the situation at that time. An Act of Parliament was passed in order to help the trade by making it compulsory that the dead should be buried in Wool. This had little effect at the time and was discontinued eventually. However, a number of the family left South Elmham, John 1418, as mentioned previously, had gone many years earlier to become well established in Tollesbury, Essex where his offspring continued sheep farming. Richard 1495 with his son Thomas was in Beccles and James 1558, the youngest son of Anthony was already in Topcroft, Norfolk.

Records state that Anthony sold his lands in South Elmham to a stranger in the year 1572, and with his family moved south to the Parish of Iken where he continued in the Sheep and Weaving business's with some success

The family had acquired an area of Hempland in this Parish and it is probable that after the temporary decline in the Wool market they turned their activity to the inclusion of Hemp. Anthony died in 1598.

William 1527 ⁽¹⁷⁾ No record.

Elizabeth 1530 ⁽¹⁸⁾ No record.

Thomas 1531 ⁽¹⁹⁾ No record.

Katherine 1533 ⁽²⁰⁾ No record.

Joan 1536 ⁽²¹⁾ No Record.

Dorothy 1538 ⁽²²⁾ No record.

The 7th Generation.

Edmund 1550 ⁽²⁴⁾ married Prudence ? ⁽²⁷⁾ and inherited the lands known as Knoddishall Hill Pightle and 14 acres of Hempland together with 3 acres of Heathland in the Parish of Iken. Edmund and Prudence had only one daughter :-

Ann ⁽²⁸⁾

John 1555 ⁽²⁵⁾ was at one time living in the coastal town of Aldeburgh, but it appears that he returned to Iken where he and his wife Isabella ? ⁽²⁹⁾ raised two children :-

John died in 1632 and the larger proportion of the Lands went to his elder son, while the land known as Colesdale Pightle went to his younger son.

James 1558 ⁽²⁶⁾ as stated earlier moved to Topcroft, he married, ⁽³²⁾ and is known to have had four children :-

The 8th Generation.

Ann ⁽²⁸⁾ the daughter of Edmund 1550, married William **Hayes**. ⁽³⁷⁾

Edmund 1611 ⁽³⁰⁾ married Heyster ? ⁽³⁸⁾ and had two sons :-

Edmund died in 1672 and was buried in Wool at Iken, while Heyster died in 1679 and was also buried in Wool at Iken.

James 1615 ⁽³¹⁾ married Mary ? ⁽⁴¹⁾ and after his death in 1641 the lands of Colesdale Pightle were handed down to her.

Francis 1595 ⁽³³⁾ married Elizabeth **Lock** ⁽⁴²⁾ at Hempnall and they had two sons :-

Edmund 1597 ⁽³⁴⁾ was at Topcroft and inherited the estate of Edmund 1550 of South Elmham.

John 1597 ⁽³⁵⁾ was also at Topcroft and married Mary **Killet** ⁽⁴⁵⁾ at Bedingham.

Cicely 1606 ⁽³⁶⁾ married George **Pitt** ⁽⁴⁶⁾ at Topcroft.

The 9th Generation.

Edward 1650 ⁽³⁹⁾ married Phoebe **Rackham** (b abt 1650) ⁽⁴⁷⁾, daughter of John Rackham ⁽⁴¹⁰⁰⁾, and apart from inheriting lands from his father Edmund he also inherited the property of John Rackham after his death.

Edward and Phoebe had three daughters, but no sons, viz :-

Edward died in 1716 and his wife Phoebe inherited the estate. She died eleven years later in 1727, and the lands were divided between the three daughters.

The 10th Generation.

Mary ⁽⁴⁸⁾ married ? **Button.** ⁽⁵⁴⁾

Elizabeth ⁽⁴⁹⁾ married Thomas **Benfield.** ⁽⁵⁵⁾

Phoebe 1680 ⁽⁵⁰⁾ married John **Newson.** ⁽⁵⁶⁾ Phoebe, being the youngest daughter inherited the largest share of her parents estate, it was the custom in those days for the younger son or daughter to inherit the property left by the parents. Phoebe, in order to inherit and pass down the property through the Fairhead line, retained the name as “ Phoebe Fairhead wife of John Newson”. She had one son :-

He carried the name of ‘Robert Fayrehead’. Phoebe 1680, the mother, died on the 30th January 1757 and was buried at Iken, and the son Robert inherited the estate.

Phillip 1669 ⁽⁴³⁸⁾ married Mary **Below** ⁽⁴³⁹⁾ at Bedingham on the 3rd October 1695, and it is from the children of Phillip & Mary that the **Parish Clerk Branch** of the family originates.

The 11th Generation.

Robert 1711 ⁽⁵⁷⁾ married Elizabeth ? ⁽⁶⁷⁾ and they had four children :-

Robert died on the 7th February 1766, and it is from his family that the second phase of the Suffolk Weavers branch starts.

The 12th Generation.

Job 1725 (72) No record.

Robert (73) No record.

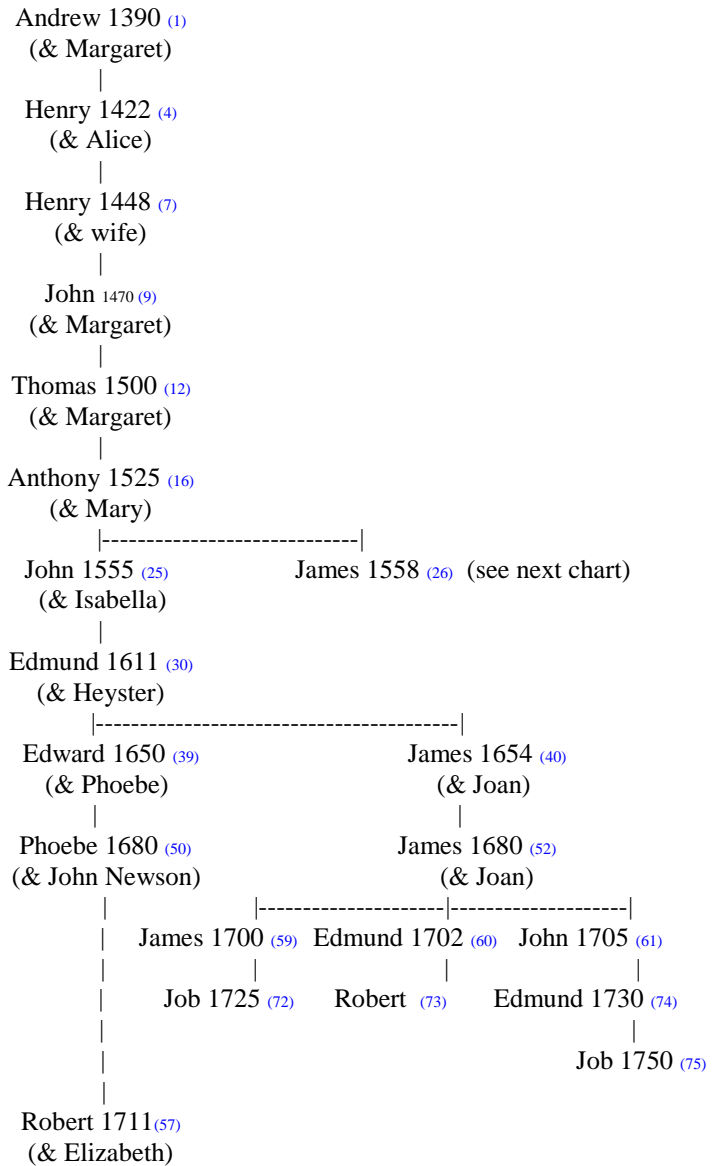
Edmund 1730 (74) the son of John 1705 is known to have had a son :-

Job (75) b 1750

No more is known about this particular family and they are thought to have died out.

The link with Bedingham, Norfolk.

"What is the relationship with me"? This question will be asked and if the Enquirer is of Bedingham stock, i.e. he belongs to one of the following branches, The Parish Clerk, or one of its offshoots, the Three Brothers or the Bricklayers; he may find the answer in this chapter.

As I (Albert) have often stated, I believe that we Fairhead's come originally from one source and in that case we are all distantly related. Although at this present time there appears to be three branches from three areas, London, Essex and Norfolk / Suffolk,

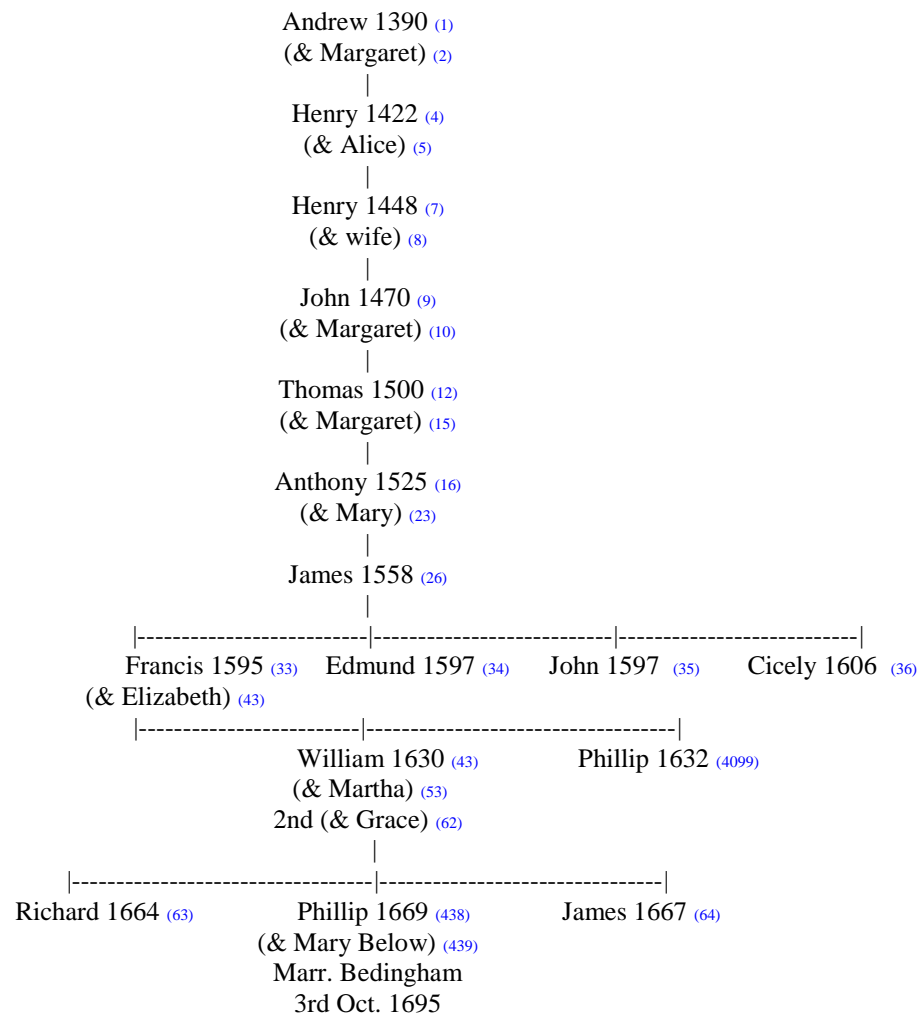
From the book "The Parish Clerk" one could learn how practically all of the Norfolk family originated from one source in the Bedingham area and I do not think that there can be any doubt that the Suffolk Weavers are of one origin, so what is needed is proof of this connection. The supporting evidence of the relationship of the two families is based on one or more facts, namely :-

1. In the will of Edmund 1550, he mentions James of Topcroft as "my kinsman". Surely here is evidence.
2. In Letters of Administration to Prudence, the wife of Edmund 1550, one third of the land she inherited went to Edmund 1580, the son of James of Topcroft. In this case James of Topcroft was in the direct line.
3. Richard 1576 of Hedenham, Norfolk is stated to be a native of Suffolk.

There are other threads of evidence that there were movements between South Elmham and Topcroft, and although it may not be generally known the movements of our Forebears in those far off days were in no way confined to the area in which they lived.

The early settlers in Norfolk came initially to the Parish of Topcroft which was largely a sheep farming area in those days very suited for the weaving trade, and at this time the family was extending its activities and looking for fresh fields.

Below is a pedigree chart showing how this connection probably came about. The pedigree chart below gives the hereditary line of some of those already dealt with and leading up to the Parish Clerk Branch.

There can never be any guarantee as to the accuracy of the make up of the pedigrees for the very early period, although every endeavour is made to make them so.

Church records, often in difficult Latin, do not reveal sufficient material to make certain the needed information, but as this only deals with the male side of the family. It does not alter the genealogical history if the father mentioned is of the same generic group, be it brother, cousin or uncle.

It appears that prior to the Fairhead settlement in South Elmham they were in the Bury St. Edmunds area, as in the Suffolk Subsidy Return in 1327 we find

Johanne Fairheued of Meleford (Melford)
Willo Fairheued of Lausele (Lawshall)
Edmundo Fayreheued of Ickworth

and in Suffolk Fines we find in the year 1377

Roger Fairheued with his wife Amicia in
 Frekenham (Freckenham) and Wrydlyngton (Worlington)

and in 1384

John Fairehevid is mentioned as a taxpayer at
 Bury St. Edmunds so now we have :-

The five mentioned might well be the forerunners of the South Elmham Weavers and subsequent members of that great family may be found in the following :-

The above with many more should fall into the genealogical story of the family. The names have been collected from many sources and although at the moment they cannot be placed in their order in the family tree, I (Albert) feel that they should be recorded and possibly some may find their place in future records of "The Fairhead Series".

I (Richard) feel the reader should be aware that the dates given above relate to the date of the record, and not to the date of birth of the person concerned, also I have no idea where Albert obtained this information.

The birth dates given throughout this book for the very early periods when church register records were not available are largely hypothetical and are mainly for identification reasons. Calculations are made as to the probable date of birth taking into account all the known facts but can in no way be accepted as correct. Some identification is necessary where so many males carrying the same Christian names are recorded.

THE SECOND PHASE.

The 12th Generation.

The second phase starts with the family of Robert 1711 ⁽⁵⁷⁾ & Elizabeth ⁽⁶⁷⁾ :-

Elizabeth 1747 ⁽⁶⁸⁾ died on the 25th March 1758.

Robert 1752 ⁽⁶⁹⁾ married Amy **Self** ⁽⁷⁶⁾ (b abt 1853) of Tunstall, Suffolk on the 10th November 1778 and they settled in that Parish to raise the following family :-

Amy died in 1844, in the Plomsgate District, Suffolk.

Sarah 1754 ⁽⁷⁰⁾ No record.

James 1756 ⁽⁷¹⁾ was admitted to the lands of his father at the age of 9 years, being the youngest son. He spent his early years in Iken, but like his brother Robert, sort a bride in the neighbouring Parish of Tunstall where he married Elizabeth **Woolnough** ⁽⁸⁶⁾ of that Parish on the 22nd November 1781 and as a result left the Parish of Iken in favour of Tunstall, where for some time he ran a Retail Shop, and where some of the family have lived ever since.

Many of the present-day Fairhead's owe their existence to this progenitor of the family name. His marriage was not long in duration as after two children were born Elizabeth died. They were :-

James married for a second time to another Elizabeth by the name of Elizabeth **Tyrrell**, ⁽⁸⁹⁾ a widow of Sutton in 1785.

It appears that James 1782 by the first marriage died in infancy, as the second marriage included a further James, the family being thus :-

James, the father, did not live to a great age, dying in 1805 (not reaching his fiftieth year) but Elizabeth his wife lived to her 83rd birthday on the 6th April 1824.

This marriage to Elizabeth also started a trend by introducing the name of Tyrrell into the family and it will be seen to crop up in future generations as a Christian name.

The 13th Generation.

Given below is the list of the 14th generation along with their parents of the 13th generation :-

Robert 1784 ⁽⁸⁰⁾ married ? ⁽⁹⁵⁾ and went to live in Chillesford, a neighbouring Parish of Tunstall where he had two sons :-

There were possibly more children but Albert was unable to trace them.

James 1786 ⁽⁸¹⁾ married Elizabeth **Plant** ⁽⁹⁸⁾ and went to live in the neighbouring village of Campsea Ashe. There a daughter was born to them :-

There may have been more in this family but no trace was found. Mary, the wife, was dead by 1851, but James lived to the age of 81 and was buried at Campsea Ash, Suffolk on the 6th April 1868.

Noah 1789 ⁽⁸²⁾ died at 18 years of age.

Mary 1792 ⁽⁸³⁾ died in infancy.

Christopher 1796 ⁽⁸⁴⁾ remained unmarried and at the time of the 1841 Census was living with his mother at 73 Tunstall. At the time of the 1851 Census was living in the house of William **Bullock** at Tunstall. He died in 1873, in the Plomsgate District, Suffolk.

Dorcas 1797 ⁽⁸⁵⁾ married John **Lincoln** ⁽¹⁰⁴⁾ on the 7th June 1824 at Rendlesham, Suffolk.

James 1782 ⁽⁸⁷⁾ died on the 6th November 1785.

Samuel 1784 ⁽⁸⁸⁾ married Sarah **Sayer** ⁽¹⁰⁵⁾ on the 9th April 1806 at Tunstall, Suffolk, and occupied a house near the church where they brought up the following family :-

It appears the weaving trade was declining for the Fairhead's at this period although there is evidence that the family was interested in Sheep right up to 1813.

However, young Samuel was apprenticed to the trade of Carpenter/Wheelwright, a trade that was becoming important at this period as the Horse drawn vehicle was of much significance and the Wheelwright was of high standard. From this beginning the Fairhead's of Tunstall emerged as among the great builders of today, Young Samuel Fairhead became a much-respected Parishioner and undertook the work of Parish Clerk. It appears that he was doing this work at the same time as Samuel 1803 at Bedingham. It is possible that these distant cousins had some contact, although as the years wore on, the family lost this connection. Records suggest that a nearer relationship existed in the earlier days.

Sarah, the wife of Samuel died on the 8th January 1854, while Samuel lived for a further twelve years and died on the 11th August 1867 at the great age of 83 years. Both were buried in the in the churchyard at Tunstall and a memorial stone marks their grave.

A sale of their personal affects was auctioned on the 30th September 1867 and a Grandfather Clock was retrieved and today it is held as a valuable memento by a great grandson.

Tyrrell 1786 ⁽⁹⁰⁾ who did not appear to have been included in the distribution of his father's estate, married Lucretia **Hill** ⁽¹¹⁴⁾ on the 11th December 1807 at Tunstall, Suffolk. They stayed in Tunstall for a time, where their first son was born, this son was :-

Although they were living in Sutton these baptisms all took place in Shottisham.

Tyrrell, like his father was a very able man and much admired in the village. Like other Fairhead's before him he became a Parish Clerk, of the adjoining Parish of Shottisham, and the Incumbent informed Albert that he witnessed no less than 37 weddings between the years 1816 and 1836. He was one of the few that could read and write at that time. About the year 1824 he moved from Sutton to Shottisham where a further 3 children were born thus :-

This makes a total of 12 children born to Tyrrell and Lucretia, although at least two died in infancy. However, Lucretia, the mother died at the age of 51 and was buried at Shottisham on the 11th June 1837 and Tyrrell married Mary Ann **Steward**, (8029) a widow, the daughter of James Woods (8030), at Sutton on the 19th December 1839.

Like many Tunstall Fairhead's, at the wedding he was described as a Carpenter. This was a rather unusual ceremony, being a double wedding, including that of Tyrrell's, bride's, father James Woods to Jemima **Scopes**. Tyrrell witnessed James Woods's union while he in turn witnessed Tyrrell's. Tyrrell was now aged 53 while his bride was 40.

The family now moved to Kirton where Tyrrell took over a farm of some 28 acres. Here he died on the 1st March 1864 and was buried at Shottisham, the Parish at which he was Clerk for more than 20 years.

Elizabeth 1789 (91) No record.

James 1791 (93) created some estimable place in this genealogical history. He was admitted to all the lands in Iken, being the youngest son, at the age of two and a half years under the guardianship of his mother, but in 1812, upon becoming of age, surrendered all the lands at Iken and moved to Tunstall, the new Fairhead home.

This young James was not interested it seems in Sheep, Wool, Farming or Woodwork and set his mind on becoming a Medical Practitioner. He had inherited considerable assets and these were put to use to bring about the desired Medical status.

He apparently made London his first choice as the first record Albert has of him is at Bow on the 25th September 1817 when he obtained a certificate as a Licentiate of the Society of the Apothecaries. His stay at Bow continued until 1845, after which time his address was stated to be 1 Montague Place, Islington and he was now recorded as a Surgeon. He married ? (127) in about the year 1820 and his son was born not long after :-

There may have been others but none are known of. It was about the year 1858 that he retired and moved to Enfield to occupy a house built for him by his nephew Allen 1825, and this is how the firm of Allen Fairhead & Son commenced building in Enfield.

James died in March 1867, aged 77 years, at Enfield and no doubt many literary reports followed concerning the work of Dr. James Fairhead.

James died on the 13th March 1901 at the age of 89 years and was buried at Blythburgh. Sophia had died more than 10 years earlier at the age of 75 years on the 2nd May 1890 and was also buried at Blythburgh.

In the 1851 Census a granddaughter, Emma Barker aged 10 was mentioned so it can be assumed that one of these daughters became Mrs. **Barker** and also at the time James, the father, was a Widower.

The residence of the newlyweds was Buck Street, Birmingham, but the stay at that address was brief as Allen and Elizabeth moved to Goal Road, Stafford. Stafford was a place which was now becoming a home for the Tunstall Fairhead's

After which the family had a sale of household effects and moved to Enfield, Middlesex in 1857, as it was stated earlier that this was in order to build a house for Allen's uncle Dr. James Fairhead (1791).

Allen made great headway in the building trade, first by the erection of houses and later as he became known, government contracts followed. When his son Allen reached adulthood he was taken into the partnership, and the firm of Allen Fairhead & Son was formed on the 20th October 1892. Later a private company came into being under the name of Allen Fairhead & Son Ltd. The firm quickly prospered and employed between 100 and 200 workmen.

Allen 1825 became a much loved and appreciated citizen but in his later years he was struck with a painful illness and he died in December 1901 at the age of 76 years.

A report from the Meyers Observer of Enfield dated the 13th December 1901 at the time of his death states that :- "He first came to Enfield to build a House for his uncle, Dr. James Fairhead and from that time he began business in the town as a Builder. At that time New Town consisted of cultivated fields and was being developed and Mr. Fairhead built many of the new houses. Later a site on Sidney and Cecil Roads was secured where large workshops were erected with a residence on the corner of Sidney and Cecil roads where Mr. Fairhead resided until 1885. It was in that year a great fire occurred in which Mr. Fairhead's shops and dwelling were completely destroyed together with a large store of Timber and other Building Material and Plant. The event was a sad one for Mr. Fairhead for the shock upon a weakened constitution arising from a previous illness caused the death of his devoted wife which was a deep and lasting sorrow. The new premises with very modern Plant and Machinery were again threatened a few years later by an adjoining outbreak, but the fear of this was not realised.

With advancing years the firm of Fairhead & Son became wider known and many fine buildings in Enfield and elsewhere have been erected by them, notably some fine schools and other public buildings. Nevertheless, he found time for work in connection with the old Parish Church which he loved so well and which he was a regular attendant. He was a Sidesman of the church for many years, winning respect and esteem and under much suffering showed a resignation to the Devine Will, a cheerfulness and a sense of gratitude which will ever remain in the memory of those who had the pleasure of visiting him during the long and painful illness".

Another earlier report from the Press reads :-

"It is with very much regret that we have to report the death, at the age of 76, of Mr. Allen Fairhead one of the most highly respected townsmen of Enfield. About 12 months ago he consulted a specialist to learn the dread fact that he was suffering with Cancer and as the disease increased in virulence Mr. Fairhead suffered considerably. The Mortal remains were committed to the grave in the presence of a large concourse of sympathetic and sorrowing spectators. At the cemetery gates the employees of the dead Master, of their own accord to the number of about 150, formed two lines between which the Cortege passed. They closed in and headed by Mr. Taylor, the Chief Clerk, and Messrs. Landray and Baines, the Foremen, followed the remains of a respected employer to their last resting place, which was lined with Evergreen. This was the family vault where for many years past had lain all that is Mortal of the late Mrs. Fairhead".

Susan Ann 1825 (123) No record.

Lucy 1827 (124) died on the 21st April of that year.

Margaret 1829 (125) married George **Goodwin**. (182)

Lucy 1831 (126) No record.

Frederick James 1822 (128) like his father also had a very distinguished Career. He went to school at Sherbourne in Dorset and was admitted to Queens College, Cambridge in 1841. He became a Bachelor of Arts in 1846, a Master of Arts in 1850, was ordained a Deacon in 1846 and a Priest in 1847. He was Curate of Wye, Kent from 1846 to 1851 and Second Master at Dudley Grammar School, Worcester from 1852 to 1853 and Headmaster of the Royal Grammar School, Guildford from 1854 to 1858.

He married Mary Montague **Holland**, (183) the daughter of John Holland (recorded profession - Gentleman) at the Parish Church of Islington on the 18th January 1849. His profession was stated as "Clerk in Holy Orders". There is no knowledge of any family.

He did not however, enjoy the riches of success for many years and died at the premature age of 36 on the 13th December 1858 at his father's home in Enfield. After his death :-

Allen followed in the same manner as his father, with continued success in the building business and giving service to the Town and Church.

He related in his latter years that he had seen Enfield Market Town developed into one of the most go ahead urban districts in the outer districts of London. Like his father before him when his sons reached maturity he brought them into partnership, the contract being entered into on the 5th April 1918.

Upon his retirement in May 1930, Allen and Mary Elizabeth received presentations from the local people of Enfield in recognition for their many services to the district. Also presented was an illuminated address containing names of all the subscribers, Allen also received a Gold Cigarette Case and Mary Elizabeth a Motoring Rug which bore her monogram. During the proceedings it was stated that "Mr. Fairhead was a Gentleman who had secured a very high reputation, not only in the district, but throughout the counties, and the name of Fairhead was the Hallmark of integrity and High-class workmanship which many beautiful churches and other buildings would testify to in future generations".

He retired to live in Worthing, Sussex and died there on the 12th November 1933 at the age of 80 years. The funeral took place at Enfield amid great respect at the Parish Church and was conducted by the Rev. G.W.**Daisley**, assisted by the Revs. E.J.R.**Howe** and J.**Frost**. All the staff and employees followed the Cortège from Sidney Road to the Church and the employees proceeded to the cemetery where they formed a Guard of Honour.

Mary Elizabeth, the widow of Allen lived a further five years and died in Worthing, in 1938, she was buried with her husband amid great respect at Enfield on the 12th September 1938.
